The standard of the rats, particularly the kittens, was very high - though some could have done with more attention to their preparation. Especially pleasing to me was the high number of exhibits in the marked section and the high standard of these was reflected in the final placings in the challenges. Congratulations to Yabba Dabba Doo Stud for BIS with a truly superb example of a PEW, to Hellstorm for a great return to the show bench with a stunning variegated kitten (that nearly ended up in my pocket!) and to Angela Corrie for a well deserved BOA with a blue point Siamese boy who was just gorgeous on all levels.

NEW VARIETIES (5): 1 (004) RCT. Russian Burmese doe. Very good base colour. Nice shade of mid grey. Very good belly. Good nose and tail points, feet pale. Good head, eye and ear. Very good type, fair size – possibly young? Sore spot on tail. 2 (006) Sue Neate. Wheaten Burmese dumbo doe. Good colour to sides, dark dorsal stripe. Good nose point, fair tail point, good ear points, feet pale. Good belly colour. Very good head and eye. Very good dumbo ears but tiny split in one. 3 (002) Mercury. Russian Burmese doe. Fair overall colour although is a little brown in tone. Fair belly. Fair nose and tail point but feet pale. Good eye, fair head and ear. Tail good but dirty. Nice size and type. Very good condition. 4 (003) Mercury. Russian Burmese buck. Good overall colour, better to sides. Patchy pale marks on mid back. Good belly colour. Pale points to nose and tail, no points visible on feet. Fair tail but dirty. Good head and eye, fair ear. Fair size and type – possibly still a youngster?

PINK EYED WHITE KIT (1): 1 (201) Yabba Dabba Doo. D. Lovely even colour. No staining – beautifully prepared. Very good tail. Very good head and ear, good eye. Excellent size and type for a kitten. Lovely condition. Very nice rat!

CHAMPAGNE/BUFF AD (1): 1 (301) Tophorne. Champagne d. Very dark for kitten, almost dark beige colour rather than warm. Very stained. Head a little broad for a doe. Good eye and ear. Fair size and type.

BRITISH BLUE AD (1): 1 (501) Aquarius. D. Good steel blue colour, slightly rusting to rump. Very good head, eye and ear. Good feet, good tail. Very good size and type.

BLACK AD (2): 1 (702) Symphony. D. Nice depth of colour. Very slight silvering to flanks. Couple of chew marks spoil overall effect. Very good feet. Good belly colour. Good tail but dirty. Very good head, eye and ear. Fair size, good type. Lovely fit doe. 2 (703) Mercury. D. Good depth of colour. Quite a lot of silvering on sides and belly. Good back feet, fair front feet. Lacks a little muscle tone. White spot under chin. Good head. Very good eye and ear. Good size and type.

BLACK KIT (3): 1 (801) Sapphire Deronal. D. Very good depth of colour. Lovely sheen to coat, shows signs of slight silvering developing. Three good feet, one white front foot. Good head, fair eye and ear. Good size and type for kitten, lovely and fit. 2 (803) Katrina Deronal. B. Very heavily (and evenly) silvered. Would be better entered in silver class. Very good feet. Fair head, eye and ear. Fair size and type for kitten. Good tail. Beats 802 on overall type. 3 (802) Sapphire Deronal. D. Fair depth of colour but already very silvered. Three good feet, one white front foot. Chew mark on shoulder. Fair head and ear, eyes a little small. Fair size and type for kitten.

CHOCOLATE/MINK AD (1): 1 (901) Tophorne. Chocolate doe. Fair top colour – nice deep chocolate, but patchy and silvered to sides. Fair belly but some silvering. Three good feet. Fair head, eye and ear. Fair tail but nobble at end. Lovely temperament, very calm girl.

IVORY AD (6): 1 (1101) Tenebrae. D. Nice even colouring, some staining to neck and mid back. Very good head, eye and ear. Good size and type but watch her weight as heading towards being a little pear shaped. Fair tail. 2 (1104) Tenebrae. B. Colour nice and even but quite heavily stained. Good thick tail. Very good head and eye, fair ears. Excellent muscle tone. Lovely big solid buck. 3 (1102) Tenebrae. D. Good even colour with very slight staining. Excellent head, eye and ear. Quite a big girl but not flabby. Masculine build – not really racy. Good size, fair type. Good tail. 4 (1103) Tenebrae. D. Fair top colour, but very stained and chewed. Very good eye and ear. Good head. Good size, fair type. Good tail.

BERKSHIRE/BADGER AD (4): 1 (1302) Hellstorm. Agouti badger doe. Good agouti colour though would like a little more fire. Lovely even blaze, ideally to have more colour to whisker bed. Very good attempt at tail stop – just a stray splodge of colour in uncoloured area of tail. Good symmetrical belly, though rather stained. Good head, eye and ear. Good size and type. Lovely fit doe. 2 (1304) Champion. Silver black Berkshire doe. Nice even silvering. Good tail stop. Very good belly. Tiny sore spot under chin. Very good feet. Very good head, eye and ear. Assume only just an adult as very petite. Lovely type – small but very fit.
3 (1301) Katie van Zyl. Agouti Berkshire buck. Lots of orange in coat, very attractive but not really to agouti standard. Good tail stop. Nice head spot. Lots of white on belly, drags up slightly to one side. Good head, fair eye and ear. Lovely temperament. 4 (1303) Hellstorm. Russian blue Berkshire buck. Very heavy heathering gives coat an unusual colour. Small head spot. Good front feet, good belly. One white back leg suspender. Spot of colour in belly white. Nice muscular boy. Fair head, eye and ear. Fair size, good type. Very unusual looking rat.
BERKSHIRE/BADGER KIT (5): 1 (1401) Hellstorm. Russian blue Berkshire doe. Nice Russian blue colour developing. Few small scabs on back. Good feet, good belly markings, slight drag to one side, one back leg has suspender. Good head, eye and ear. Good size and type for young kitten. Very good tail stop, trying to grow a full head spot from a couple of white hairs. 2 (1403) RCT. Black badger doe. Very nice depth of colour – a little silvered. Very nice blaze. Good feet and belly. Tail more mottled than a distinct tail stop. Very good head, eye and ear. Lovely type. Nice size for kitten, nice and fit. 3 (1404) Sophie Denoral. Black Berkshire doe. Lovely depth of colour to coat. Nice solid black. Very small tail stop. Good amount of white to belly but very ragged and zipper under chin. Very good head and ear, good eye. Really nice fit typey kitten. 4 (1402) RCT. Black Berkshire doe. Very good tail stop. Good head spot. Good feet. Very good white belly but brindles to sides. Quite a lot of white on face. Good head. Very good eye and ear. Good size and type for young kitten.
HOODED AD (1): 1 (1702) Halcyon. Black buck. Lovely depth of black colour. Very good hood, nice and even to shoulders. A little ragged under with a slight zipper. Nice even saddle – a bit wide for standard. Could do with more colour on tail. Lovely thick tail. Very good head and eye, good ear. Nice solid typey buck. Under of tail very dirty which rather spoils an otherwise lovely buck.
HOODED KIT (1): 1 (1801) Ian Hayward Chamberlin. Black doe. Nice dark black colour. Very good hood, nice and even to shoulder. Good under though has thin zipper. Very good attempt at saddle – lovely and narrow and reasonably even. Very good attempt at tail. Good head, excellent eye and ear. Good size for youngster. Super type for kitten.
VARIEGATED AD (6): 1 (1902) Hellstorm. Black buck. Good colour. Good clean under. Head spot elongated. Lovely variegation on back going down to sides. Good head and eye, fair ear. Good size and type. 2 (1904) Hellstrom. Black doe. Very nice colour. Good size head spot but a little long and thin. White patch to one side of face. Good clean under. Very good variegation, nicely broken up. Ideally would like to see more on the right side. Good head and ear, fair eye. Fair size, nice type. Good attempt at tail. 3 (1906) Hellstorm. Black doe. Good colour. Head spot very long and thin. Good clean under but very stained. Fair attempt at variegation on back but a bit blocky. Needs more colour to sides and tail. Sore toe on front foot. Fair head, eye and ear. Fair size and type. 4 (1903) Hellstorm. Cinnamon buck. Very nice colour, lovely russet tones. Blaze rather uneven. Lovely clean under but a little stained. Tail lacks colour but hard to see in this variety. Fair variegation – a little blocky and needs more on sides. Fair head. Very good eye and ear. Good size and type.
VARIEGATED KIT (2): 1 (2002) Hellstorm. Black doe. Good colour. Good attempt at head spot. Slightly too much white to one side of face. Good clean under. Good tail. Lovely variegation – really exceptional. Small but very fit kitten in good condition. Definitely one to watch for the future. 2 (2001) Hellstorm. Black doe. Good colour. Head spot more of a stripe than a spot. Good clean under. Very good attempt at variegation, ideally needs more colour to sides. Good tail. Good head, fair eye, ears a bit crinkly. Small but fit kitten – shows promise.
CAPPED KIT (1): 1 (2201) Hellstorm. Black doe. Good colour. Fair jawline but colour needs to extend lower on to jaw. Fair head spot – a little long. Good colour stop at ears. Good clean under. Top a little stained. Stray spot of colour to shoulder. Small kitten but fit and typey. Good head. Fair eye and ear. Very good attempt at a difficult variety.

ESSEX KIT (1): 1 (2401) Rivendell. Agouti Essex buck. Nice depth of colour, Good gradation developing to sides. Very good head spot. Fair feet. Good under. Good head. Very good eye and ear. Good tail. Lovely fit kitten. Good size and type.

Very close class, wins on eye. 2 (3101) Kyra Murray. D. Lovely depth of colour, excellent short coat. Very good belly and good feet. Very good head and ear, good eye. Good tail. Lovely size and type. A little excitable today.

RUSSIAN BLUE KIT (3): 1 (3202) Katrina Deronal. D. Very good depth of colour for kitten. Very good belly colour. Good feet. Good ear, fair head and eye. Fair size and type for kitten. 2 (3201) Sophie Deronal. B. Fair colour, a little pale as yet and silvering on sides. Very good feet. Nice fit kitten. Good broad skull. Fair eye and ear. Nice size and type for kitten. 3 (3203) Katrina Deronal. B. Fair colour but heavily silvered, belly also silvered. Fair head, eye and ear. Very good feet. Good tail. Good size, fair type.

RUSSIAN BLUE AGOUTI AD (5): 1 (3502) Champion. D. Very attractive mix of blue and fawn. Very good belly. Nice dark undercoat. Stunning eyes. Excellent ear. Good head. Lovely racy type. Very good tail. Good size. 2 (3504) Halcyon. D. Fair colour, a little dark to spine. Fair belly, a little pale. Undercolour lacks blue tone. Fair head. Good eye and ear. Quite masculine build, not very racy. Good size. Solid, well built girl. 3 (3505) Mercury. B. Colour quite good overall, a little brown to the sides. Good belly. Good feet. Good head, fair eye and ear. Watch his weight, a little flabby. Very chilled out chap. 4 (3501) Rivendell. D. Fair colour, a little heavy on the fawn. Good belly. Good undercolour. Good head, eye and ear. Good size, fair type. Good condition.

HIMALAYAN AD (1): 1 (3901) Symphony. BE doe. Nice even white coat colour, some slight staining to neck and shoulders. Grubby tail spoils. Very good nose and tail points. Pale points to feet but are discernible. Very good head, eye and ear. Good size and type.

SIAMESE AD (1): 1 (4101) Angela Corrie. BE buck. Good overall shading, a little patchy to shoulders. Very good points all round. Good head, fair eye and ear, fair tail. Nice solid typey buck.

BLUE POINT SIAMESE AD (3): 1 (4303) Angela Corrie. BE buck. Very good depth of shading, a little patchy on rump. Very good nose, tail and ear points, foot points a little paler. Very good tail. Very good head. Good eye and ear. Lovely big muscular buck. 2 (4302) Mercury. D. Some shading but a little uneven. A little stained to neck. Good points all round. Good head, ear and eye. Very nice fit typey doe. 3 (4301) Felicity Shields. BE doe. Lacks shading. Heavily stained. Very good nose, tail and ear points, foot points a little pale. Good tail but a bit grubby. Very good head and eye. Good ear. Good size and type. Nice fit rat.

GUIDE STANDARD (4): 1 (8703) Halcyon. Golden Himalayan doe. Nice shade of apricot. A little patchy on rump, stained on neck. Good belly. Very good nose, tail and ear points. Pale feet. Very good head, eye and ear. Good size. Very nice typey doe. 2 (8701) Symphony. Golden Himalayan buck. Nice delicate shade of apricot but hard to see any silver ticking. Good nose and tail points, feet pale. Good belly. Good eye and ear, fair head. Fair tail – rather dirty. Good size, fair type. 3 (8702) Halcyon. Golden Himalayan buck. Colour quite patchy and heavily stained. Thin tail for a buck – rather grubby. Little scab on rump. Good belly. Good nose, tail and ear points, feet pale. Good head and eye, fair ear. Good size and type. 4 (8704) Halcyon. Golden Himalayan doe. Fair colour – a little pale and very patchy, some shading to rump. Quite heavily stained. Good nose, ear and tail points, pale feet. Good head and eye, fair ear. Good size, fair type – a little pear shaped.

A thoroughly enjoyable show and a pleasure to be asked to co-judge alongside my better half, Sheena. A great atmosphere, good natured throughout and busy all day long! Many thanks to my attentive steward Jane and my equally attentive scribe Felicity. I had some very nice rats placed before me, but some of them were let down by poor show preparation; silly things like unclipped claws or dirty tails, some of these sadly from exhibitors who should know better. I was also horrified to see rats being shown in obviously broken show tanks, which are dangerous to the rats, the judge and the stewards. I would have been perfectly justified in disqualifying these. Remember; presentation isn't just about the rat, the show tank counts too!

There was no blood on the carpet between the two judges on choosing our top places, with the kittens having the best end of the deal. A superb PEW doe from Yabba Dabba Doo was a worthy winner, with a beautiful variegated kitten owned by Hellstorm which took RBIS. Best Opposite Age was taken in fine style by a blue point Siamese Buck owned by Angela Corrie. As far as Stud Buck was concerned, for us there was only one winner, a truly stunning silver fawn dumbo owned by RCT. Congratulations all! Well done and thanks to Mary and Rackie for running a super show and many thanks to all exhibitors for supporting what was a worthy 35th anniversary show.

SILVER FAWN AD (4): 1 (4901) Rivendell. D. Nice rich colour. Nicely silvered. Good belly and fair demarcation. Smallish yet. Good type. Sharp claws! 2 (4902) Comis. D. Good colour. Good belly, fair demarcation. Slight chew mark by tail. Good bold eyes. Tail a little grubby in parts. Good type. 3 (4903) Comis. B. Good rich colour although slightly patchy to rear. Good white belly, pale demarcation. Excellent size and masculine type. Good broad skull. Very handsome rat. 4 (4904) Tenebrae. D. Good even colour. Good white belly and fair demarcation. Showing middle aged spread. Slightly sore patch on tail. Slight yellowing to rear under.

SILVER AD (5): 1 (4901) Tenebrae. Silver chocolate buck. Excellent silvering – even overall. Extends to forehead – very good. Good even chocolate colour. Good size and type – nice muscular fellow. Good feet. Good broad skull. 2 (5107) Angela Corrie. Silver black buck. Very good silvering overall, extends onto belly. Good depth of colour and good feet. Good bold eyes. Nice size and type. 3 (5102) Tenebrae. Silver black buck. Very nice silvering, slightly more prominent to sides, very good on belly. Nice even black coat, Good feet. Rather small yet but should bulk out nicely and shows great potential. 4 (5105) Symphony. Silver black. Very nice dark colour. Fair silvering – nice and even. Good feet. Nice solid rat. Fair size and good type.

AGOUTI AD (4): 1 (5301) Halcyon. D. Very, very good colour. Excellent blending of red, brown and black. Excellent belly colour and clear demarcation. Excellent bold eyes. Youngster yet but with huge potential. Very attractive rat. 2 (5102) Yabba Dabba Doo. B. Lovely rich red colour, slightly darker on back. Good grey belly but slightly stained. Good size but no stranger to the food bowl. Good type, nice bold eyes. 3 (5305) Aquarius. D. Quite nice rich colour. Slightly dark on back. Good belly. Bit overweight. Coat rather staring – think she's a little bit stressed. 4 (5304) Ann Clifton. D. Colour rather patchy. Fair belly but rat feels undernourished and out of condition. Nice bold eyes. Fair type but needs attention.

AGOUTI KIT (2): 1 (5402) Rivendell. D. Colour coming through nicely, particularly to flanks. Still rather dark on back. Good belly. Nice bold eyes. Sharp claws and dirty tail Fair size and type. 2 (5401) Rivendell. D. Rather dark yet. Colour showing nicely red to flank. Good belly. Lacks show preparation – very sharp claws and filthy tail. Fair size and type.

CINNAMON AD (1): 1 (5501) Ann Clifton. D. Fair colour but rather dark on back. Coat rather patchy and silvered – coat lacks lustre. Nice belly. Good bold eyes but a little underweight and hunched.

BRITISH BLUE AGOUTI AD (3): 1 (5701) Tanya Manuel-Warner. B. Good blue colour overlays fawn very nicely. Good belly colour. Good ears and tail. Fair size, good type. Nice solid chap. 2 (5703) Aquarius. D. Blue colour rather subtle and overwhelmed by fawn. Good belly colour. Fair eyes and tail. Nice size and type. 3 (5703) Aquarius. D. Nice blend of colours producing pleasing overall effect. Good belly colour. Good foot colour. Nice thick tail. Good bold eyes. Nice overall size and type.

PLATINUM AGOUTI KIT (1): 1 (6401) Rivendell. D. Fair colour, yet to show full potential. Belly not very distinct. Fair feet. Nice ruby eyes. Fair size and type for youngster. May show better older. Lacks preparation – very sharp claws.

SELF REX AD (1): 1 (6502) Felicity Shields. Black buck. Good dark colour. Few minimal silver guard hairs. Rexing developing nicely. Good feet. Nice bold eyes. Small scab on back. Fair size and type. Will show better as he gets older.

MARKED REX AD (1): 1 (6701) Halcyon. Black hooded buck. Good rexing – even throughout. Good hood with small zipper under chin. Very good saddle. Good tail colour. Good size and type. Groin spot spoils overall effect.

MARKED REX KIT (2): 1 (6801) Ian Hayward Chamberlin. Black hooded doe. Rexing pleasantly fuzzy – typical for kitten. Nice curly whiskers. Fair colour. Slightly moulty on shoulders. Good clean hood with small break under but no chin zipper. Good saddle – broadens slightly to base. Very good tail colour. Small rat but size acceptable. 2 (6802) Halcyon. Agouti hooded buck. Fair rexing. Nice red agouti colour. Good hood, zipper under chin. Nice saddle, broadens to base. Good tail colour.

RUSSIAN REX AD (1): 1 (6901) Mercury. Russian blue agouti buck. Good depth of colour. Rexing shows undercolour very nicely. Nice tight curls consistent over rat to belly. Good broad skull. Very good size and type. Sadly tail rather grubby.

AOV REX AD (1): 1 (7302) Felicity Shields. Agouti buck. Fair rexing - nice and wavy. Nice rich red agouti colour. Good belly. Little small yet, but youngster. Tail rather skinny. Nice bold eyes. Will improve with age.

SELF DUMBO KIT (1): 1 (7601) Yabba Dabba Doo. PEW doe. Good even colour. Fair ears, one quite creased. Nice size and type. Rather out of sorts – maybe a long show day.

RUSSIAN DUMBO AD (6): 1 (7905) Mercury. Russian blue agouti doe. Very good colour overall. Blends nicely. Good belly. Good sized ears – one slightly creased. Nice thick tail though with slight scabs. Good size and type overall. 2 (7906) Mercury. Russian blue agouti. Good colour overall. Nice and blended. Nice size ears but creased. Good size and type. Bold eyes. 3 (7901) Kyra Murray. Russian dove doe. Nice even colour. Nice pale belly. Well shaped ears. Fair size, good type. 4 (7902) Champion. Russian blue. Nice even colour. Good shiny coat. Nice big ears but creased. Good feet. Nice size and type but still youngster.

RUSSIAN DUMBO KIT (1): 1 (8001) Mercury. Russian blue buck. Still young yet – colour yet to develop fully. Rather grey. Nice bold ears – very slight creases. Will show better older.

AOV DUMBO AD (5): 1 (8302) Tanya Manuel-Warner. Agouti. Good agouti colour, showing nice red to flanks. Good belly colour. Good ears, nicely shaped. Good size and type. 2 (8301) Comis. Silver fawn doe. Very nice bright silver fawn, demarcation line sharper on one side. Very good ears. Youngster yet but shows great potential. Nice bold eyes. 3 (8305) RCT. Silver fawn buck. Excellent silver fawn colour, good and rich. Very nice belly and demarcation. Excellent size and type. Good thick tail. Good big ears, slightly creased. Fine broad skull. Overall a very nice rat but with sharp claws. 4 (8303) Tanya Manuel-Warner. Silver black buck. Good depth of colour and very good silvering – even overall. Fair ears, a little creased. Very good size and type. Good feet.

REX DUMBO AD (2): 1 (8501) Mercury. Russian blue agouti doe. Good depth of colour and belly. Nice rexing, soft and wavy. Good ears, nice size. Fair size and type. 2 (8502) Mercury. Russian blue doe.
